

Campers may reach Sandy Wagner, Camping Attendant by going to the festival office.

**YOU MUST DISPLAY AQUA RECEIPT IN CAMPER/TENT WINDOW DURING FESTIVAL WEEKEND!**

- Campers are allowed in park after 5:00am EST on Thursday, August 22nd, 2019. No early arrivals! No picnic tables to be chained or taken until your camper is in the park. Only one table per camper permitted until tables are gone. The festival committee recommends that to be guaranteed a picnic table you should provide your own.
- Personal golf carts, ATV's, gators, bicycles, skateboards, scooters (ORV's) are not allowed anywhere in park or park grounds (this includes parking lots) on Labor Day Weekend.
- Pet/Animal Notice: No pets allowed on festival grounds, this includes campground, campers, or boardwalk area. Plan accordingly!
- No air conditioners are to be operated during kick off weekend (weekend before festival) or festival weekend.
- All campers in the numbered spots need to park length ways in their spot. Any questions or changes need to be taken up with the camping attendant. Do not put up any type of stakes, rope, twine, or any other boundary marker.
- Set your trash bags along the road or fire lane to be picked up daily.
- Parents: Adventure Park closes at 9:00pm EST. All children should be at campsites by 11:00pm EST. Quiet time is at 12:00am EST, meaning no excessive noise or activity permitted.
- No vehicles are allowed in the campgrounds during the Festival weekend. All cars and trucks must be out of the campground by 7:00 p.m. Friday, August 31st. Vehicles are not allowed at any time until Monday move-out. You can park them in the parking lots adjacent to the camping areas. Only vehicles with proper current Handicap permits are allowed to park in the Handicap lots – others are subject to be towed without further warning.
- Gray Water Dumping Notice: Dumping of "gray water" or sewage directly onto the ground or into a container is prohibited by Indiana State and Federal law! IDEM enforcement officers will be on site and will issue fines to violators. The Earl Park Fall Festival will not be held responsible for violations of state and federal regulations. If caught releasing gray water, you may be asked to remove camper from the park, immediately with no refunds.

- You must come to the Fall Festival Office on Sunday, September 1st, or Monday, September 2nd, 2019 from 11am-1pm EST to pick up your 2020 camping reservation form and to pay any outstanding camping fees for 2019. Camping for Kick Off Weekend, any night the week before the festival and any night the week after the festival is \$15.00 per night and may be paid at festival office.
